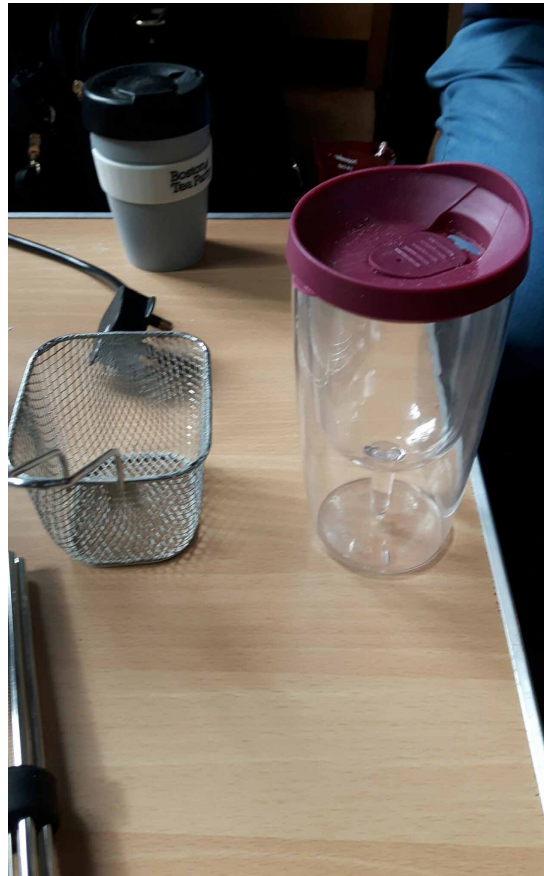


SALISBURY SHAKERS
